
Anti-Virus Tips

Don't open any email attachments from an unknown person.

Don't open any email attachments unless you know what the attachment is. Even though you know the person who sent it, the virus could have duplicated itself and spread through their address book. Make sure your contact really sent the attachment before opening it.

Don't fall for the subject lines that promise "Pamela Nude" or "Lottery winner", etc.

Delete chain emails and junk email. Don't forward or reply to them. These types of email are considered spam.

When in doubt, throw it out!! If you're unsure about an email, delete it.

Back up your files regularly. Along with your Documents, remember to backup your email and address book. If a virus destroys your files or your system has to be formatted and re-installed, you'll have a backup.

Update your anti-virus software regularly. Schedule your virus program up automatically update every few days.

AVG now has the Linkscanner feature working with Google Search. It scans each page found through the search and reports on its status.
